HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION - We remind everyone that August 15th, the Glorious Assumption of the ever-blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven, is a Holy Day of Obligation. ALL Catholics are expected to assist at Holy Mass that day. The High Mass, here, will be at 6 PM following the Holy Rosary. Because it is Thursday, it will be accompanied by Novena to the Most Holy Infant of Prague and Benediction. Plan to be here. What a blessed day! Where She is we hope to follow! It is a Plenary Indulgence Day here at Her Shrine.

PLENARY INDULGENCE - This month we are thrice blessed. We can obtain the Plenary Indulgence on: the 13th, Fatima Day as each month; the Assumption on the 15th; and also on the 22nd, Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. No wonder miraculous things happen here for those who want them! Do not waste these Gifts from God and His holy Church!
