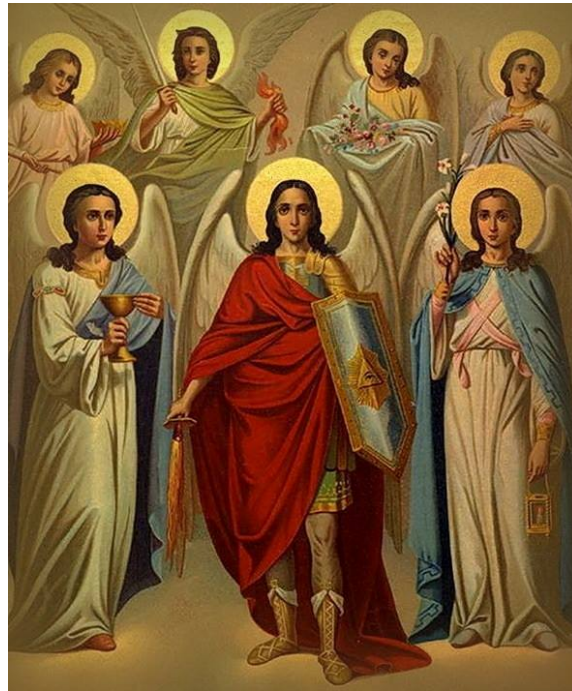


## MASS INTENTIONS, SAINTS and ASSIGNMENTS
