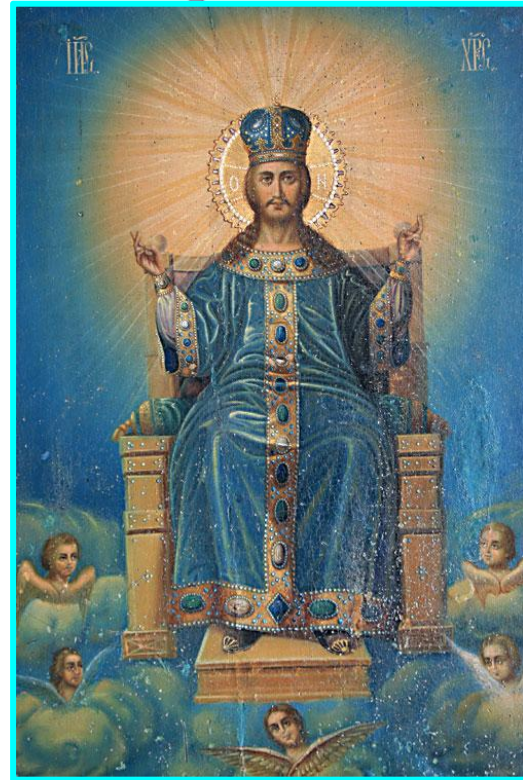


WELCOME TO THE SHRINE of OUR LADY

VOLUNTEERS - Now that we have come to the great celebration of Christ, King of the Universe, we have to begin preparing for Advent and Christmas. We will need help decorating the Hall and the Church. The Nativity Scene in the Church will be set up right before the Feast of the Immaculate Conception (Dec. 8th). The Outdoor Nativity Scene will be set up the Saturday BEFORE Thanksgiving. All hands on deck!

OPEN HOUSE - Our traditional Advent and pre-Christmas Open House will take place on Friday, Dec. 13th in the Church with the Brass ensemble and many other things - plus food and drink - in the Canon Pérez Parish Hall.

CHRISTMAS CARDS - Our custom made Christmas cards are available in the Hall and in the back of the Church. Make all checks to the St. Stephen Holy Name Society. Not too early to start preparing!

PLENARY INDULGENCE - Beginning with All Souls' Day, those who go and pray, even if briefly, to a cemetery can obtain a Plenary Indulgence for the Holy Souls in Purgatory.

ALL SOULS' DAY - In the Foyer you may find All Souls' Day envelopes so you can remember all your dearly departed on that day reserved to them as well as all the month of November. Please return them back ASAP with the names of All your deceased printed clearly (also on note paper inside). Rev. Canon will explain how to make your offering.

ALL SAINTS' AND ALL SOULS' DAY - As this year these days fall upon so-called weekend days, All Saints' Day is a Holy Day of Obligation. ALL Catholics are obliged under pain of mortal sin to attend Mass on this day. We will have a High Mass at 6 PM following the Rosary. On All Souls' Day, we will have a Requiem Mass at 8:30 AM. Though not of obligation it is most important to attend Mass for the Dead. Where they are, you will be soon!

CHRISTMAS ORNAMENTS - It is not too early to get ready for Christmas as we begin to celebrate the Holy Year 2025. We have designed some beautiful commemorative Christmas ornaments of our Shrine and Parish, with the purpose also of raising monies for our next Building Projects. They are \$30 each. Make checks payable to the St. Stephen Holy Name Society. They make lovely gifts, as well! Our own Christmas cards are available as well!

MORNING RETREAT - Very Rev. Canon Pérez will hold a morning of recollection for ALL Legionaries on Saturday, Nov. 9th.
