SEPTUAGESIMA - On NEXT Sunday, February 16th, we already start the season of penance known as Septuagesima, seventy days before Easter. Our Lord is born to die for our salvation, and the Liturgical Calendar of the Traditional Mass gets right to business. Though we begin slowly, we already start to prepare for Lent, or Quadragesima. Plan your calendars ahead.

AGNUS DEI - One of the most prized sacramentals of the Church throughout history (now discontinued) were the little discs of blessed wax that were fashioned from all the candles presented to the Pope on Candlemas. They were melted and the little discs engraved with the Lamb of God were placed in little silk pouches by holy nuns. They were given to the Faithful as gifts.
