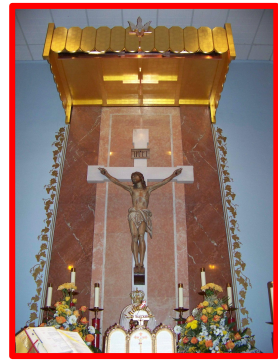

EASTER DUTY - All Catholics are reminded that we have an obligation according to Tradition and Law to confess our sins (even if not mortal) during the period beginning with Ash Wednesday and ending with Trinity Sunday, June 15th. This is called the Easter Duty. Try not to go on the busiest days or wait 'til the end...

COURTESY - In your kindness would all of you please wipe your feet before coming in the Church or Hall? Also, please help keep our Parish Hall clean by picking up after yourselves & your children and throwing all trash away. We do not want any uninvited little visitors... Thank you!
