## THE ANGELUS AND THE SALVE REGINA

With the "Time throughout the Year" that begins with the Feast of the Most Blessed Trinity, the Marian Antiphons switch once again. The Angelus returns (at 6 or 8 AM; Noon; 6 PM) and the Regina Coeli is put away until Easter next year. The beautiful and ancient "Salve Regina" or "Hail, Holy Queen" also returns. We reproduce them here in Latin and English for your use and edification. Pray these also at home with your family!

*Salve Regina*, mater misericordiae:  
Vita, dulcedo, et spes nostra, salve.  
Ad te clamamus, exsules, filii Hevae.  
Ad te suspiramus, gementes et flentes  
in hac lacrimarum valle. Eia ergo, Advocata  
nostra, illos tuos misericordes oculos ad nos  
converte.

Et Iesum, benedictum fructum ventris tui, nobis,  
post hoc exsilium ostende.  
O clemens: O pia: O dulcis  
Virgo Maria.

*V.* The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.

*R.* And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail, Mary...

*V.* Behold the handmaid of the Lord.

*R.* Be it done unto me according to thy word. Hail Mary...

*V.* And the Word was made flesh.

*R.* And dwelt among us. Hail Mary...

*V.* Pray for us, O holy Mother of God.

*R.* That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray: *V.* Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the Incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an Angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection. Through the same Christ, our Lord.

*V.* May the Divine Assistance remain with us always.

*\*R.* And with all our absent brothers, and may the souls of the Faithful Departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.
