THE ANGELUS AND THE SALVE REGINA

With the "Time throughout the Year" that begins with the Feast of the Most Blessed Trinity, the Marian Antiphons switch once again. The Angelus returns (at 6 or 8 AM; Noon; 6 PM) and the Regina Coeli is put away until Easter next year. The beautiful and ancient "Salve Regina" or "Hail, Holy Queen" also returns. We reproduce them here in Latin and English for your use and edification. Pray these also at home with your family!

Salve Regina , mater misericordiae:

Vita, dulcedo, et spes nostra, salve.
Ad te clamamus, exsules, filii Hevae.
Ad te suspiramus, gementes et flentes
in hac lacrimarum valle. Eia ergo, Advocata
nostra, illos tuos misericordes oculos ad nos
converte.

Et Iesum, benedictum fructum ventris tui, nobis,
post hoc exilium ostende.
O clemens: O pia: O dulcis
Virgo Maria.

- V. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary.
- R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail, Mary...
- V. Behold the handmaid of the Lord.
- R. Be it done unto me according to thy word. Hail Mary...

HOLY MASS - There is no better prayer or mode of beseeching Almighty God for favors than the frequent, even daily, attendance to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Sacrifices you may make in order to do so are nothing compared to all the graces you will receive-and yes-answers to your prayers! Make every effort to assist at Mass more frequently! You will not regret it.

EASTER DUTY - We remind everyone who has not done so that the time for the obligatory Confession required by the Church for your Easter Duty ends with the Vigil of the Feast of the Trinity, June 14th.

FATHER'S DAY - This Sunday is Father's Day. We wish all the fathers in our Parish and all those elsewhere a most blessed day. In the Foyer, you may still find envelopes for your requests for Father's Day Masses. Canon will pray for them for a month. Make any checks to him.

FIRST COMMUNICANTS - All parents who have children that are hoping to make their First Holy Communion on June 22nd, the External Solemnity of Corpus Christi, please email Canon so he can tell you what is required. It is not necessary that they be Theologians. The Basics are required and, above all, a consciousness of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Our children will make their First Confession on the previous day, Saturday, June 21st, immediately after Mass and Novena to Our Lady of Fatima. Parents please make sure you talk to Rev. Canon regarding the obligatory dress code for the First Communion.
