**COLLECTION** - Those who care to continue to help us in our mission, please send your donations by mail or use online giving on our website ([latinmasspensacola.org](http://latinmasspensacola.org)) by making a withdrawal using your credit card (for which the Parish will incur about a 4% charge) or directly from your bank. **THANK YOU FOR YOUR GENEROSITY.** We remind everyone what a serious obligation it is to tithe to our Parish! It is a commandment from God...

**CSA** - Have you made your pledge for this year's CSA. We have already made our Goal for 2025. Anything else that comes goes to our Savings. Our insurance for this year is about \$48K! We have already paid it but we need to replenish our Savings Account. Be as generous as you can.

**PROPER ETIQUETTE** - With the warm months already here, we need to remind all that proper dress is required in attending Mass and the Sacraments: no shorts, sleeveless shirts or dresses; skirts should properly be below the knee. Also, Parents, please do not bring hard toys that can scratch the pews. (Careful with the keys!) We so appreciate your cooperation!

**THURSDAY** - ALL are reminded how important it is to attend the devotions (Rosary, Mass, Novena to the Infant of Prague) on Thursday evening. Sponsored by the Holy Name Society, but not only, it is a very important part of our Parish and Shrine! Be here!

**ST. BENEDICT** - All St. Benedict medals, etc. have been blessed and may be retrieved from the Sacristy.

**SCAPULAR** - The Feast of Our Lady of Carmel is on July 16th. Very Rev. Canon will bless and impose the Brown Scapulars on those who have not had this done previously. No need to repeat. Once this has been done all scapulars are automatically blessed. This will be done after the High Mass on the Sunday closest to the Feast - that is on THIS Sunday,

**ANOINTING** - Anyone who is seriously ill or about to have surgery please notify Canon Pérez AHEAD of time. Make sure to make a good Confession and then set up an appointment for him to give you the Sacrament of Holy Unction.

**PLENARY INDULGENCE** - We remind everyone that we are very privileged here at the Shrine of Our Lady because we can receive a Plenary Indulgence (erasure of all our Purgatory if properly received) on the 13th day of every month (Fatima Day) and on First Saturday as well as other Feasts. Take advantage of this!

**BURSE CLUB** - It is time to donate to the education of future Priests for this Diocese. The Burse Club, begun in 1922 by our first organist, Katherine Geist Marques, entails an offering of \$12 a year. Canon will start it off with \$120. Can you match or better him? Give donations to Canon or Ellen Miheve, President of the Ladies' Sodality.
