THURSDAY - ALL are reminded how important it is to attend the devotions (Rosary, Mass, Novena to the Infant of Prague) on Thursday evening. Sponsored by the Holy Name Society, but not only, it is a very important part of our Parish and Shrine! Be here!

HOLY DAY - This coming Friday, August 15th, is the Solemn Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into Heaven. Because of that, Mass will be at 6 PM, NOT in the morning. ALL Catholics are bound to attend Mass on this day under penalty of mortal sin. **BE SURE TO BE HERE!**

CZESTOCHOWA - Every year we give thanks to Our Lady of the Assumption of Czestochowa, whose Feast is August 26th. It is a Plenary Indulgence day for our Parish and Shrine.
