SEPTUAGESIMA AND LENT - In the Gregorian Rite and Calendar (Martyrology) we begin this Sunday with the pre-Lenten season of Septuagesima. This means some changes in the Liturgy (no Alleluias, etc.), purple vestments unless otherwise specified, and more opportunities for fasting and penance. The main part of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18th. More information next week. **ALL** are encouraged to make the most of this wonderful opportunity to grow in grace.

CANDLEMAS - We will have our customary celebration on February 2nd, the Feast of the Presentation of the Child Jesus in the Temple, Candlemas Day. The Rosary will begin at 5:30 p.m., followed by the Blessing of the Candles (you can also bring your own to be blessed), Procession, and High Mass at 6 p.m. It is the Fortieth and Last Day of Christmas traditionally. There will be a short reception in the Hall afterwards.

ANOINTING - We remind all that on the Saturday closest to the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes Canon will be conferring the Sacrament of Unction, Anointing of the Sick, after the 4 PM Vigil Mass. All those who are chronically sick or over the age of 60 can and should be anointed. You should be in the state of grace and go to Confession sometime before.

CSA - It is almost time to start the new campaign for the Catholic Sharing Appeal. Participation is also required to be a formally registered person/family in our Parish.
