ANOINTING - We remind all that **NEXT** Saturday closest to the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, February 14th, Canon will be conferring the Sacrament of Unction, Anointing of the Sick, after the 4 PM Vigil Mass. All those who are chronically sick or over the age of 60 can and should be anointed. You should be in the state of grace and go to Confession sometime before.

ST. BENEDICT - Anyone who has St. Benedict medals and other sacramentals is reminded that Canon will proffer the special Blessing on these on two days only: March 21 and July 11th. More information to come. Get your medals ready in time.

LENT - With Septuagesima and the pre-Lenten season which we have already started, it is not too early to start thinking about how you can make this upcoming Lent more special and grace-filled than the previous years. Use this time wisely.

COMMUNION - Only those who CAN receive Holy Communion should approach the Altar Rail (except little ones with their parents). No blessings will be imparted at that time. The Final blessing for ALL is at the end of the Mass.

Beginning on February 3rd until Easter this is the proper Marian Antiphon that is sung in the Sacred Liturgy.
