**FLOWERS** - In the Foyer, you will find envelopes for the collection of funds for the flowers for our Altar and Church at Easter and the ensuing festivities. Rev. Canon will remember all the names you turn in, as well as the Donors, in all his Masses during the Fifty Days of Easter. Be as generous as you can be! Thank you!

**MAY CROWNING** - As customary on Mother's Day, Sunday, May 10th, the girls of our shrine will crown the image of Our Lady. All girls under 15 are invited to be part of this procession before Mass. One girl will be selected by Rev. Canon to actually do the crowning. Girls are asked to wear white or blue dresses and mantillas. The Mothers may accompany them for this great honor.

**MOTHER'S DAY** - In the Foyer you may find the envelopes for your Mother's Day Masses for your own mothers and spiritual mothers. Please make all checks to the Rev. Canon. He will remember them all at Mass for one month.

**CSA** - Have you made your pledge for the 2026 CSA yet? Remember, this is required to be a registered practicing member of this Parish. Necessary for First Communion, Confirmation, and Matrimony.
