FATIMA DAY - We remind everyone that May 13th marks the great Anniversary of the Apparition of Our Lady at Fatime in 1917. We will renew our consecration and love for Her that night after Mass during Benediction. All are encouraged to come and honor our Patroness and Mother!

ASCENSION - As traditionally, we will be celebrating the Ascension of Our Lord into Heaven on Ascension THURSDAY, May 14th. For Traditional Catholics it is a holy day of obligation. Mass will be at 6 PM and will be followed by Novena to the Infant Jesus of Prague. The traditional Novena to the Holy Spirit will start on Friday and be prayed very day after the Sermon. Plan to be here.

MAY CROWNING - As customary on Mother's Day, Sunday, May 10th, the girls of our shrine will crown the image of Our Lady. All girls under 15 are invited to be part of this procession before Mass. One girl will be selected by Rev. Canon to actually do the crowning. Girls are asked to wear white or blue dresses and mantillas. The Mothers may accompany them for this great honor.

MOTHER'S DAY - In the Foyer you may find the envelopes for your Mother's Day Masses for your own mothers and spiritual mothers. Please make all checks to the Rev. Canon. He will remember them all at Mass for one month.

CSA - Have you made your pledge for the 2026 CSA yet? Remember, this is required to be a registered practicing member of this Parish. Necessary for First Communion, Confirmation, and Matrimony.

PARENTS - Parents of children who will make their First Holy Communion and Confirmation on Pentecost Sunday need to get in touch with Rev. Canon before May! Children who made their First Communion the last two years need to be Confirmed as well. Start going through the Catechism and prepare for this great Sacrament!
