The Seven Sorrows

The Seven Sorrows (or Dolors) of Mary are key events in the life of the Blessed Virgin Mary that focus on her profound grief and suffering alongside Jesus Christ.

- The Prophecy of Simeon** (Luke 2:34–35): Simeon tells Mary that a sword will pierce her own soul.
- The Flight into Egypt** (Matthew 2:13–21): Joseph and Mary take Jesus to Egypt to escape King Herod's slaughter.
- The Loss of Jesus in the Temple** (Luke 2:41–50): Mary and Joseph anxiously search for the young Jesus for three days.
- Mary Meets Jesus on the Way to Calvary:** Mary encounters her son as he carries his heavy cross.
- The Crucifixion and Death of Jesus:** Mary stands steadfast at the foot of the cross, watching Jesus die.
- Mary Receives the Dead Body of Jesus:** Jesus is taken down from the cross and placed in her arms.
- Jesus is Placed in the Tomb**
